# BASIC FIRE OFFICER PROGRAM YORK COUNTY

The Maine Fire Service Institute has developed this new training program to address the need to better prepare firefighters to command and manage today's fire service. The goal is to give new and prospective officers the skills necessary to effectively manage and lead their companies and departments in the challenges of the rapidly changing fire service. Topics include assuming the role of company officer, introduction to leadership and management, fire service organization, legal issues facing the fire service, communications, health and safety, incident management, emergency response, on scene management and communications, and strategy and tactics for single company operations.

The course material is based on national fire officer qualifications under NFPA 1021. The Participants will complete a brief written project after each class which will reinforce the concepts discussed in class.
