## Train-the-Trainer

Members of the Maine Fire Chiefs Association and the Maine Department of Inland Fisheries & Wildlife, with support from the Maine Fire Service Institute, have partnered to provide Maine's newest training program. The course is designed to meet the formal safety and training needs of agencies throughout the state who already employ an OHRV (Off Highway Recreation Vehicle) as well as those who are looking to purchase an OHRV in the future. This cost-effective program will help create a standard for safety and risk-reduction as they relate to the use of these unique off-road vehicles. It will also satisfy the training requirements for ATV and Snowmobile Safety certification through the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.

This training is intended to be distributed widely throughout the state utilizing instructors who are certified at the Fire Instructor I level. We encourage mutual aid participation, as we have found firsthand the importance of working with our neighbors on calls utilizing this equipment.

We are seeking 12 instructors from around the state to help distribute this training to their geographic area. If you are interested in developing your own skills and delivering OHRV trainings at the local level, this Train-the-Trainer event is for you!

**The first OHRV Train-the-Trainer is scheduled for Friday, June 21 from 0800 - 1600 at the North Yarmouth Fire Department, located at 463 Walnut Hill Road, North Yarmouth.**

**A second Train-the-Trainer event is tentatively scheduled for sometime in September.**
