Fire Investigator: Principles and Practice to NFPA 921 and 1033



Course Location: Westbrook Fire Department 570 Main Street, Westbrook ME

Course Dates: May 4 - May 8, 2020

Course Times: 0800 - 1700 daily

Cost: \$100 per person; includes lunch

This 40 hour course will provide the training necessary for departments to conduct fire investigations. Participants will learn basic principles and practices of fire scene investigation, evidence preservation, report writing, and fire chemistry. This course will meet both NFPA 921 and NFPA 1033 requirements. Guest instructors will include: agents from ATF, Maine Solid Fuel Board, Maine Electrical Inspectors, and other subject matter experts.

Course attendance is limited to 30 attendees. Each applicant must also provide written acknowledgment from their sponsoring Fire Chief, verifying that they are (or will be) responsible for conducting fire investigations for their department.
