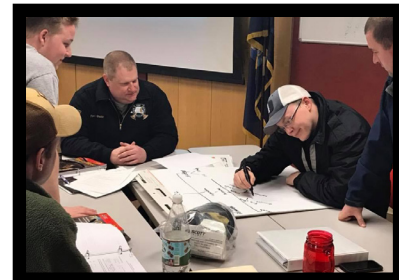


MFSI is proud to present a newly created bridge program from Fire Instructor I to Fire Instructor II. This program was established in anticipation of introducing the NFPA Live Burn Curriculum to Maine's fire community. The NFPA standard requires that presenters and instructors involved have Fire Instructor II credentials to lead live fire burns, and we know that there are many dedicated individuals in the field who currently have Fire Instructor I only. The NFPA 1041 standard for Fire

Instructor has changed significantly over the past decade or more, but one fact remains the same: skillful instructors are vital to every dynamic, successful educational program. While facilities, instructional materials, equipment and personnel with specialized technical knowledge are also needed, without instructors who are fully competent and up-to-date in the art of teaching, no educational program can be completely successful. This program will refresh you in areas previously discussed and bring you the latest in relevant laws, diversity training, lesson plan development, Training in Context, objective writing, Department of Labor requirements, and more. *Applicants must hold a current Fire Instructor I Certification (does not need to be ProBoard accredited).*

Successful completion of all course requirements by qualified individuals will allow them to sit for the ProBoard Fire Instructor II certification exam in accordance with the 2019 edition of NFPA Standard 1041.

Hybrid Delivery: Zoom & In-Person Sessions at EMCC in Bangor (Public Safety Training Center, Room 104)





Attendance is mandatory for all sessions. This program is conducted partially via Zoom - candidates must have reliable Internet access.



A portion of the program fee (\$150) is non-refundable for participants who withdraw after the start of the course. The registration fee includes a copy of the Jones & Bartlett textbook, and the J&B online platform. An Exam Prep Book can be provided on a loan basis to students by request. Scholarships may be available for qualifying students. Please contact MFSI (207-844-2078) for more information about scholarship opportunities.
