MFSI is thrilled to announce two pilot offerings of our new Fire Officer I delivery model, hosted at MFSI headquarters in Brunswick and in the Bangor region. Space will be limited to 18 candidates per program.

This course is designed for the first-line company officer/supervisor and satisfies the requirements of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 1021 Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications, Chapter four "Fire Officer I". It is designed around classroom lectures and group exercises to improve your abilities to manage a single fire company. This includes responsibilities such as the development of an Incident Action Plan (IAP), personnel management and mentoring, and community relations.

Upon completion of this course you are eligible to take the National Board on Fire Service Professional Qualifications (Pro Board) written exam and skills testing. Participants that receive a Pro Board certification are eligible for certification through Maine Fire Service Institute.

The deadline to apply for this program is October 7, 2022. Prior to Orientation, candidates who are accepted into the program must complete a three-hour writing class via Zoom: for your convenience, this can be completed on Tuesday, October 11 from 6:00-9:00pm, or on Saturday, October 15 from 9:00am-12:00pm. The mandatory Orientation session will take place on October 24, 2022 and the class will meet every other Monday evening from 6:00-9:00pm for 16 weeks (8 total classes).

Course Prerequisites:

In order to become ProBoard certified at the completion of the course, applicants must have obtained Fire Fighter I & II and Fire Instructor I certification (these do not need to be at the ProBoard level). In addition, 5 years of fire service experience and ICS 100 & 200 are required prior to the start of the course. The latter can be completed online at training.fema.gov/nfa.
