Attendance is mandatory for all sessions. This program is conducted partially via Zoom.

Course description: This 60+/- hour course is designed to meet or exceed requirements of the Maine EMS identified standards for courses that lead to licensure for Instructor Coordinators, as well as the NFPA 1041 standard for Fire & Emergency Services Instructor I & II Professional Qualifications. Class time is spent on instructor roles, audience analysis, communication skills, the writing of objectives, presentations, and evaluation methods. Each student is required to prepare and deliver both a 10-minute and a 20-minute classroom presentation. This course requires the use of a laptop or computer and reliable access to the internet to complete online assignments.

Recognition/Credit & Preferred Prerequisites: All students who successfully complete the course will receive a ProBoard certificate as meeting the NFPA 1041 standard for Fire & Emergency Services Instructor I & II Professional Qualifications. This course is designed for both Fire & EMS staff. For fire service members, the preferred prerequisites are: NFPA Fire Fighter I and II and 3 years of fire service experience.

The registration fee includes a copy of the Jones and Bartlett textbook and other materials. The Exam Prep Book can be provided on a loan basis to students by request.
