

COMMAND & CONTROL OF INCIDENT MANAGEMENT N0312

In this 6-day National Fire Academy course, fire officers are introduced to the Incident Command System (ICS), and they study proper command techniques for control and extinguishment of fires ranging from small, residential structures to multioccupancy, commercial complexes.

Topics covered include:

- Problem-solving and fire command
- Interagency and mutual aid
- The ICS and incident management
- Size-up, strategy, tactics and action plans
- Truck company and engine company ops
- Building construction and fire behavior
- Pre-incident preparation, incident organization and strategic command

During this course, students will participate in a series of simulations of emergency incidents. Members of the class assume roles, assess different types of emergency situations, and make command decisions under realistic incident conditions. The simulations are a critical component of this training experience. They give students an opportunity to apply the knowledge and practice the skills learned in the classroom in a safe and supportive environment, as well as reinforcing the lessons learned and helping students make the transition from the classroom to the incident scene.
