Firefighter Training Program 2025

The Presumpscot Valley Fire Academy (PVFA) announces the start of the 2025 Firefighter I & II Training Program.

Program Overview:

The academy prepares the recruit for National Board on Fire Service Professional Qualifications (Pro Board) Certification through Maine Fire Service Institute, which will be offered at the completion of the Presumpscot Valley Fire Academy Training Program. Firefighter I and Firefighter II programs both meet and exceed the requirements of 2019 Edition of NFPA 1001: Standard for Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications, as well as the requirements for Operations Level Responders in the 2018 Edition of NFPA 472: Standard for Competence of Responders to Hazardous Materials/Weapons of Mass Destruction Incidents. Individuals needing only a Firefighter II certification will have the ability to enroll on a case by case basis. The PVFA provides recruits with a Maine BLS certification during the training program once those objectives have been met.

The 2025 training program will start with orientation on **January 15, 2025** and run through May 28, 2025 with anticipated MFSI practical skills testing anticipated on June 7, 2025. Components of the program include approximately 300 hours of training achieved by Classroom Instruction, Practical Skills Training, Independent Curriculum Study, Online Testing, Occupational Cancer Awareness and Best Practices Education, Physical Fitness and Wellness Training.

Students interested in this program must be willing to commit a significant amount of their time to successfully complete the academy. Both programs are college level courses with up to (6) college credits that can be awarded from Southern Maine Community College. Students should expect college level reading assignments, homework assignments, quizzes, exams and physically demanding skill development

Academy Dates, Times and Locations:

Sessions will meet on Monday and Wednesday evenings from 6:00 PM to 10:00 PM and most Saturdays from 8:00 AM until 4:30 PM unless otherwise noted in the schedule. Please be aware that these times are only guidelines and reflect the anticipated Instructor-Recruit contact time. Classes will be conducted at the various host departments and the Hollis Training Facility with a primary location at Gorham Central Fire Station, 270 Main Street, Gorham, Maine 04038

Firefighter I & II: \$1500.00

Firefighter II: \$1000.00

Medical Clearance:

Candidates shall be covered by the sponsoring department's Workers Compensation Policy; are not presently drawing Worker's Compensation Benefits; OR if not sponsored by a department have applicable health insurance; meet the requirements of the Maine Respiratory Protection Standard (1910.134); have successfully received a medical clearance within a year of this application date based on the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 1582: Standard on Medical Requirements for Firefighters; and are aware of the physical demands of the firefighting training program.

December 14, 2024 at 1700 hours. No Exceptions.
