Deputy Chief Marc Bellefeuille Instructor of the Year Award

The Instructor of the Year award has been established and dedicated to the memory of Deputy Chief Marc Bellefeuille who was widely respected as a State of Maine Fire Service Instructor for Maine Fire Training and Education. He also served as the coordinator for the Maine State Weekend at the National Fire Academy providing many Maine firefighters the experience of the National Fire Academy in Emittsburg Maryland. He dedicated 38 years to the fire service before retiring in April of 2011. The "Deputy Chief Marc Bellefeuille" Instructor of the Year will be presented to the State of Maine fire service instructor whose actions and performances serve as an example to the profession, within the State of Maine fire service. The instructor of the year demonstrates an ongoing commitment to serving Maine's fire service by teaching and encouraging others to progress themselves and/or their organization in pursuit of excellence. Any Maine Fire Service Institute Fire Instructor in good standing serving in the state of Maine is eligible for nomination. Nomination forms will be available on the MFSI website.

The Instructor of the Year Award recognizes individuals for extraordinary accomplishments in fire service training. The awardee shall meet the following criteria:

- Will have displayed a deep commitment to furthering the cause of the fire service through training
- Will have brought creativity and innovation to the fire training programs or will have shown great persistence in pursuing innovative programs
- Will have served as a positive model for other instructors and firefighters
- Shall have demonstrated ethical conduct reflected in the MFSI Instructor Code of Conduct and Ethics
- Will have advanced the cause of firefighter operational effectiveness and safety.
- Will have gone beyond the call of duty in training
