By signing below, you indicate that you agree to the following Code of Conduct.

Each MFSI State Fire Instructor shall:

- 1. Create a Positive Environment: Foster a welcoming and supportive learning space for all students.
- 2. Encourage Critical Thinking: Support students in expressing their ideas and thinking independently.
- 3. **Ensure Safety**: Take steps to protect students from harmful physical conditions.
- 4. Stay Substance-Free: Avoid using drugs or alcohol immediately prior to and during class.
- 5. **Show Respect**: Treat all students fairly and provide equal opportunities.
- 6. Protect Privacy: Respect each student's privacy and confidentiality.
- 7. **Maintain Professionalism**: Keep a professional relationship with students.
- 8. Avoid Embarrassment: Never intentionally shame or belittle a student.
- 9. **Promote Inclusivity**: Create a learning environment free from inappropriate comments related to race, ethnicity, religion, politics, or sexuality.
- 10. Use Respectful Language: Avoid profane or abusive language.
- 11. Focus on Success: Strive to impart knowledge that contributes to students' success.
- 12. **Meet Course Goals**: Teach according to the objectives set by the Maine Fire Service Institute.
- 13. **Teach Within Qualifications**: Only teach subjects or parts of the curriculum you are qualified for.
- 14. Follow Copyright Laws: Adhere to all copyright regulations.
- 15. Use Required Materials: Utilize at least the materials identified as required by MFSI.
- 16. Maintain Ratios: Ensure proper student-to-instructor ratios are upheld.
- 17. Report Issues: Inform MFSI about any curriculum concerns or negative dynamics.
- 18. **Avoid False Statements**: Do not make misleading or harmful statements about the Maine Fire Service Institute, SMCC, or its curricula.
- 19. Be Honest About Qualifications: Present your qualifications accurately and transparently.
- 20. Support the Mission: Act as an ambassador for MFSI and support its mission at all times.
